Lesson Description

Overview	Students will use a computer with internet access to research information about turtles
	in Ontario. They will use this research to create trivia flash cards to test their peers'
	knowledge about turtles.
Activity	 Start by introducing the activity. Explain that the students will be creating their own trivia flash cards about Ontario Turtles to test their peers' knowledge on the subject. Share the provided examples (see attached worksheet) with the class so they
	have an understanding of what they need to create.
	Next, allow the students time to conduct their own research on a computer with internet access and to complete the attached worksheet.
	4. There are 6 categories as part of the trivia game and each student is in charge of completing 1 card per category (or 2 cards per category depending on the size of the class, if this is the case then you must print 2 copies of the worksheet for each student to complete).
	5. Once they have completed their research the students should cut each trivia card out and hand them into the instructor.
	6. Divide the cards into each category and shuffle.
	7. Ask the students to find a partner and then divide the cards evenly amongst the students. The students will then quiz their partner on the trivia card in their hand.
	8. Once complete have the students find a new partner and repeat the process of quizzing.
	9. Finally, ask each student to share a new fact they learnt about turtles.
